Conwy Lodge has two bedrooms.

There is a double bedroom on the ground floor and on the first floor, there is another bedroom with one double bed, one single bed, a cot and an ensuite bathroom.

There is a ground floor bathroom with a bath and separate shower, a small kitchen-diner and beamed lounge with log burner.

Outside you'll find a barbecue area, maintained garden and car parking.

Facilities

Facilities at Conwy Lodge include gas central heating, flat screen TV with freeview, WiFi, fridge, freezer, washing machine, microwave, garden furniture.

Bed linen and towels are supplied. All fuel costs including logs for the fire are included in the rental.

ABOUT THE PROPERTY

Pets

We do allow pets but we ask that you please clean up after your dog.

Refrigerator & Freezer

Located in the storeroom off the kitchen. The milk is fresh for your use. Please ensure you take all perishable items with you at the end of your stay.

Washing Machine

This is located in the outhouse building at the back of the property.

Logs

These are also located in the outhouse building.

Light Bulbs/Matches

Spare bulbs and matches are located in the cupboard under the stairs.

Council Bin Collection

There is a green 'wheely' bin provided for rubbish. This is collected on Wednesday morning. Please ensure the bin is placed outside the property adjacent to the track the previous evening and bring the bin in after it is emptied.

Garden

The gardener, Mally, may attend the property during your stay.

BBQ

There is a stone BBQ built to the rear of the property for your use. The grill is located in the store in a black plastic black. Please leave the BBQ clean and return the grill the store after use.

Garden Furniture

You will find a table and chairs in the log store opposite the kitchen. These are for your pleasure; please leave them in a condition you would expect to find them.

Livestock

The fields surrounding the lodge are used for livestock. These animals can be intimidating and we ask that you advise your children accordingly and keep pets under control.

Pond

A pond is located in the field to the side of the property. A variety of wildlife can often be seen however, please remember that children must be supervised wherever open water exists.

HISTORY OF THE PROPERTY

Conwy Lodge was built in 1894 and is one of the three original gate lodges serving Gloddaeth Hall, now a school called St. David's College.

One of the other two lodges can be seen across the fields and the other is located just behind Llanrhos Church.

The inscription above the ground floor window 'Heb Dduw, Heb Ddim; Duw a Digon' is one of the families mottoes and is Welsh for 'Without God, without all; God and plenty'.

Gloddaeth Hall, built in the reign of Queen Elizabeth 1, was one of the ancestral homes of the Mostyn family until the death of Lady Augusta Mostyn in 1911.

Lady Augusta was very much the driving force behind the development of Llandudno and without her Llandudno would not be the beautiful coastal resort it is today.
